



































PRODUCT DECOMPOSITION DIAGRAM



REGULATION



When shooting the Airsoft Gun for a target or game, you and all participants must wear goggles or other eye protective gear, also paying attention to ricochets. (Pay sufficient attention also to third personnel other than participants.)




Never aim or shoot a person or animal as the target, Always attach the protective plug to the muzzle, except when you are ready to shoot a target.




You may be punished if you are shooting for a practical joke.



Avoid pulling the trigger carelessly.




Never shoot the Airsoft Gun at places where people and cars pass cross.



Always direct the muzzle towards a safe direction.




Always put the Airsoft Gun in a case or bag when you are carrying it.




Store the Airsoft Gun at places out of reach by children




BB bullets may be shot out even if the magazine is removed.



Release and put away your fingers from the trigger, except when you are ready to shoot a target.
